

PACKING LIST (or what you will be losing this summer!)

Here I will give you the mystical list, passed down from generation to generation! If you would like to see your items come home with you, **mark everything with your name or initials!**

- **Class A Scout Uniform (MARK ALL CLOTHING WITH NAME OR INITIALS)**

- Shirt
- Shorts
- Scout Socks
- Belt
- Neckerchief and 2 Slides
- HANGER!!!
- Brown or Black Shoes or Boots
- Merit Badge Sash (IF you have Merit Badges)
- OA Sash (IF you are a member of OA)

- **Other Clothing (not Scout)**

- Socks (8-10 Pair)
- T-Shirts (6-8)
- Long Pants (1)
- Shorts (2)
- Poncho/Rain Gear
- Hiking Shoes or Boots (See Uniform)
- Tennis shoes
- Closed-toe water shoes (for tubing - No Crocs!)
- Underwear (8-10)
- Two Bathing Suits and Towel (Pool and River use)

- **Toiletries**

- Soap in a watertight carrier
- Towel and washcloth
- Toothbrush and Toothpaste
- Comb or Brush
- Shampoo and Conditioner
- Metal mirror (optional)

- **Camping Gear**

- Flashlights (1 large, 1 small), with new batteries!
- Water Bottle (VERY IMPORTANT)
- Mess Kit and Eating Utensils for Outpost and Saturday Family Cook-out
- Coffee Mug (Adults ONLY)

- **Bedding**

- Sleeping Bag or Blankets
- Pillow and Case
- Flat twin sheet (for extra warmth, or for cover on hot days!)

- **Other Items**

- Pocket Knife, Sharpening Stone (Optional, MUST HAVE Tot'n' Chip - can get there)
- Notebook and Pencils
- Watch (Optional, but useful)
- Camera and Memory Cards (optional, and not an expensive one)
- Scout Handbook (if you want to earn any achievements)
- Post card or envelope with paper, stamped and addressed (IMPORTANT - ticket for Tuesday Lunch)
- Plastic bag or laundry bag for dirty clothes
- Anti-fungal powder or spray (Gold Bond is the scout's choice!), ChapStick, Sun Screen
- Flip-Flops (for the showers)
- Ear Plugs
- Medicines and inhalers (Bring Sunday AM in original bottles in a ZipLoc Bag with scout's name on it - Adults may do the same for THEIR personal meds, or self-administer - not your child's)
- Money for lunch on day up, snacks, merit badges, special interest programs (more on that later)
